# EZEUDO UMUCHU'S TIMELESS LEGACY OF WISDOM AND INFLUENCE

"Great men are not born great, they grow great," Mario Puzo once said. Chief Sir Sylvester Chukwudozie Ezeokenwa, KSJI (Ezeudo Umuchu), was one such man. Some 70 years ago, he was born. On Thursday, May 15, 2025, he slipped away quietly, just as he lived, leaving behind footprints too deliberate to be erased.

Born into the noble lineage of Late Ezennanya Ezeokenwa Ezeanyim of Umumilo Village, Amanasaa, Umuchu, his foundation was deep and dignified. His mother, Late Catherine Egbeichi, a yam merchant in Nkwo Uchu, taught him resilience through her grit and industry. From his father, he inherited the kind of dignity Ralph Waldo Emerson called "the only thing that never fades."

His academic path began at Ogbarimgba Primary School, continued at Central School Umuchu, and culminated at St. Peter's School, Achina, where he distinguished himself in the WASC exams. Yet, when duty called, he answered, not for himself but for his family. Forfeiting admission into Alvan Ikoku College of Education, he chose to pave the way for his younger siblings. As Lincoln said, "The best way to predict your future is to create it" and he did so, through sacrifice.

In business, he was a visionary. From the cobblestones of Paris to Germany's industrial cities, London's markets, and Italy's elegance, he left Umuchu to plant his dreams across continents. But this wasn't mere travel it was purpose. He eventually established a strong footing in Nigeria's oil and gas sector, nurturing it with unwavering discipline and determination. One could imagine Thomas Edison seeing in him a kindred spirit, for as Edison once said, "Genius is one percent inspiration and ninety-nine percent perspiration."

Politics didn't tempt him it summoned him. In the 1980s, he served as a Councillor in Onitsha Local Government under the Social Democratic Party (SDP). He was among the foundational architects of the PDP in Anambra and helped secure its 1999 victory. When governance derailed, he co-pioneered the Anambra People's Forum (APF), a moral response to political decay, echoing Edmund Burke's timeless warning: "The only thing necessary for the triumph of evil is for good men to do nothing."

Then came a dream of an Igbo political identity. Not surprisingly, he was there, sketching the blueprints of what would become the All Progressives Grand Alliance (APGA). CTD.

# EZEUDO UMUCHU'S TIMELESS LEGACY OF WISDOM AND INFLUENCE

For thirteen faithful years, he served as Chairman of APGA in Onitsha South, wielding influence not with noise, but with native wisdom and strategic foresight. He didn't shout, but he was heard. He led with wisdom, proving Lao Tzu right: "A leader is best when people barely know he exists."

In December 2014, his people crowned him Ezeudo, King of Peace. It was not just a title; it was recognition. He had chaired Amanasaa Community and guided the Umuchu Improvement Union through delicate times. He brought order where there was chaos, structure where there was drift. His voice, though gentle, was final. "Peace," Ronald Reagan said, "is not absence of conflict, but the ability to handle conflict by peaceful means." Ezeudo embodied that. His devotion to the Church was no less fervent. He helped build St. Matthew's and SS Peter &

Paul Catholic Churches, led the Bazaar Committee, and served as Second Vice Chairman of the Parish Pastoral Council. His faith, like C.S. Lewis described, was not a feeling but a choice quiet, steady, and sure.

But perhaps his most enduring legacy is not in brick or title, but in character passed down. He raised a son, Barrister Sly Ezeokenwa Jnr, APGA's National Chairman. A son whose moral clarity and political astuteness reflect the father's tutelage. In him, the virtues of Ezeudo; humility, loyalty, courage, patience, discipline live on.

With his wife, Lady Emilia Ezeokenwa, he built a strong family of five children, nineteen grandchildren, and a legacy destined to outlive memory.

Victor Hugo once said, "To be a saint is to be an exception; to be a great man is to be a rule." Chief Sir Sylvester Ezeokenwa was both. His life was a quiet proverb, his death a solemn pause. And even now, though the pillar has fallen, the foundation still holds.

As Maya Angelou reminded us, "Nothing can dim the light that shines from within." Ezeudo's light still shines quietly, wisely, eternally.

Finally, I have come to the harshest reality of my life.

Today is the 1st day of June (your birth month), yet this scary dream, this excruciating nightmare has turned a reality. I have waited this long simply to live in denial. As condolence visitors poured in, I was clinging on to hope. Just maybe, just somehow, a director somewhere will call an end to this scary movie.

How does one begin to erase memories that have lasted over 4 decades? How does one disentangle himself from the very life he lives and the love you exuded? How do I begin to write about you, my dearest father, in the past?

I recall vividly your last moments.

What started like a routine hospital appointment turned into my most painful reality ever.

I had insisted that you be taken to the hospital when I was informed that you were weak.

Daddy, you know how intentional I was about your health.

I visited you on Sunday morning on my way to church for my Thanksgiving Mass.

You were still weak, so weak that you barely muttered appreciation prayers to Mr. Governor for the honour he gave to you and the blessings he brought to your family.

Ezeudo m, while expressing my appreciation in church to our guests (yes, our guests because as far as I am concerned, you were the host), I broke down in tears; if nothing, I realise now in hindsight it was a dangerous premonition.

The next day, you slipped into a coma.

Your final days were a harrowing experience for me,

I cried, I prayed, I hoped,

just like I did 6 years ago when you were amputated.

I was hopeful you were going to pull out of the coma and make full recovery.

Who would blame my positivity,

to me, you were the strongest and bravest person I knew.

What you had previously endured had broken millions.

Ezeudo nna m, in your sick bed, I gave you my most treasured asset; the medal of our Lady of Perpetual Help, I entrusted you to her maternal care.

I didn't stop at that, I invited over 10 priests to pray for you; I know how much you loved the church and her priests (another virtue I learnt from you)

I remember when I made the first mistake as a teenager, I got pregnant at 19. The tears in your eyes broke me, but you told me it's not the end for me. You took it upon yourself and saw me through the 9 months journey, the sleepless nights, you will never go out and return home without buying snacks and, fruits for your pregnant daughter. Some nights I will wake you up to complain about my pains, you massage my legs to make sure it doesn't swell, everything you did for me without complaining for once or even frown your face.

After that you will still drive me home by yourself, with bags of rice, beverages, tubers of yam to mention but a few with the cash that follows. You never let me go hungry for one day in that 8 years of marriage experience, When the marriage crisis came, I called you and you said as I quote, "AADA NNE, WHATEVER YOU DECIDE I WILL SUPPORT YOU 100%". My happiness and well-being was your utmost priority.

I am forever grateful for the memories we created together, the late-night talks, the laughter, the dance steps, and all that you sacrificed for me, you were my playmate. ADA ICHIE' as you fondly call me. You taught me Strength, kindness and Resilience.

Fast forward to 2019, when sickness came, you were unconscious for weeks, from Onitsha hospital to Nnewi, from Nnewi we ended up in Enugu. I stayed with you for months, I held your hand so strong, cried and Prayed, you entered into Coma a couple of times, I sat by your bedside, refusing to let go, didn't close my eyes to sleep for days, until you came out of coma. In the end, your leg was Amputated, I gave you my strength, my Energy, my time. I left the world behind and stayed with you. CTD.

I assisted every step you took, holding your hand so strong until you got back on your feet again. This journey of life would have ended that year but God gave us more time, 6 years of more bonding, more friendship, more laughter and more jokes. Because you will never wake up a day without calling me on the phone, to check on me and my children, you will always tell me 'Nne jisikwa Ike, Odighikwa easy at all, to be a single parent. 'Your strength and advice kept me going and it will keep me going till forever. Even on a sick bed, Daddy, you kept providing for me. Your main concern is making sure that I'm never hungry, that I don't lack anything.

2021, when I Joined Nollywood, I came home with the ID card (Actors Guild of Nigeria) you were so happy, I wanted to move to Asaba, I was worried about you, how you will cope? How you will walk without me? But you assured me that you will be fine, you said 'ADA NNE, you have a long way to go, you have kids to take care of, just keep making me proud' we talk on phone every now and then.

When this sickness that took you away from me came, I was called that you were rushed to hospital, mom said you haven't eaten for two days, and you haven't talked to anybody or even said anything. I came to the hospital, immediately I called you Daddy, you answered me, mom was surprised, but little did I know it will be the last you will answer me. I brought your food and started feeding you, you didn't resist, you started eating, how am I supposed to know it will be the last I will feed you. I left with joy that you will soon be discharged. The next morning, I called and your voice sounded so lovely and lively, poor me, I never thought it would be the last I will hear your voice over the phone. Daddy, that your voice that morning still rings like a bell in my head.

And then my sister called again after some days, that you entered into Coma again, and was placed in the ICU, and on oxygen. Fear gripped me, I didn't know what to think or do, I just started crying, I started praying but just like it happened, it was time for you to go and rest, time for you to go beyond and make a way for us your children, especially me your lovely daughter. Daddy you closed your eyes and didn't open it again. I knew you struggled to stay with us, to stay for me but God knows the best.

A Vacuum irreplaceable you have created. I cry myself to sleep every night, hoping you will call or come and tell me it's okay.
